ELIGIBILITY: Any Student who is entering or attending any accredited *college, university, technical or trade school or institution of higher learning. A scholarship is available to anyone who has participated in the Northeast Washington Fair. This Scholarship is open to students who have attended Public, Private or Home school.

You may not be the son or daughter of any member of the executive Board or paid employee of Northeast Washington Fair.

APPLICATION: The application form for this scholarship should be neatly prepared and should present, in orderly and concise terms, a summary of your activities, accomplishments, community service and objectives of further education. The deadline for turning in the application is April 10th of the year of application. This may change each year.

PAYMENT: Award of scholarship will be made to the student upon our receipt of proof of enrollment to accredited college, university, technical or trade school or institution of higher learning.

AMOUNT: The Northeast Washington Fair Association will award as many scholarships as money allows, depending on applications received and money available. The Northeast Washington Fair Association has the right to issue NO scholarship at their discretion.

Only one scholarship per student, however any student may re-apply if they were not awarded the scholarship in the previous year.
