

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
TO CONSIDER PROPOSED SPECIAL ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR
LAKE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT 1-2018 AT LOON LAKE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Board of County Commissioners of Stevens County, Washington on **Monday, October 22, 2018, at 2:30 p.m.** in the Commissioners' Office; 230 E. Birch Avenue; Colville, Washington. The purpose of the hearing is for the county legislative authority to act as a board of equalization and consider previously submitted written objections, if any, to the proposed special assessment roll. The total amount to be collected by the special assessment roll is \$350,000 over five years with collections beginning in 2019. The legislative authority may correct, revise, lower, change, or modify the proposed special assessment roll or any part thereof, or set the proposed special assessment roll aside and order a new proposed special assessment roll to be prepared.

The proposed special assessment roll is available for public perusal during normal business hours (8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.) on all business days in the Commissioners' Office at the above address.

OBJECTIONS TO THE PROPOSED SPECIAL ASSESSMENT MUST BE IN WRITING, INCLUDE CLEAR GROUNDS FOR OBJECTIONS AND MUST BE FILED PRIOR TO THE HEARING WITH THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF STEVENS COUNTY, WASHINGTON. FAILURE TO SO OBJECT SHALL BE DEEMED TO WAIVE AN OBJECTION.
