NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Stevens County Commissioners in the Commissioners' Office located at 230 East Birch Ave. (old AVISTA Bldg); Colville, Washington on Tuesday, March 26, 2019 at 3:15 p.m. The purpose of the public hearing is to review community development and housing needs, inform citizens of the availability of funds and eligible uses of the state Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and receive comments on proposed activities, particularly from low- and moderate-income persons and persons residing in the Stevens County area. Grant funds in the amount of \$90,271 will be available to Stevens County and Rural Resources Community Action to fund public service activities that principally benefit low- and moderate-income persons. The draft application for the Stevens County/ Rural Resources Community Action proposal will be available for review at the Stevens County Commissioners' Office; 230 East Birch Ave. (old AVISTA Bldg); Colville, Washington beginning March 20, 2019. Office hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays. Comments may also be submitted in writing to the Stevens County Commissioners by mail at 215 S. Oak; Colville, WA 99114 until 3:15 p.m., Tuesday, March 26, 2019. Comments on the County's and Community Action Agency's past performance and use of the 2018 CDBG Public Service Grant award will also be received. The Commissioners' Office is handicap accessible. Arrangements to reasonably accommodate special needs, including handicap accessibility or interpreter, will be made upon receiving 24-hour advance notice.
