Ordinance No. 01-2011

CREATING LAKE MANAGEMENT
DISTRICT 1-2011 FOR CONTROL
OF EURASIAN MILFOIL AND ANY
OTHER STATE-LISTED AQUATIC
AND/OR RIPARIAN NOXIOUS
WEEDS at DEER LAKE

WHEREAS, the Board finds that ballots were officially tabulated on July 12, 2011 on the issue of whether or not to create a lake management district at Deer Lake for the control of Eurasian milfoil and any other state-listed aquatic and/or riparian noxious weeds; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that a simple majority vote in favor of creation of the lake management district was received;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that Lake Management District 1-2011 is hereby created for control of Eurasian milfoil and any other state-listed aquatic and/or riparian noxious weeds at Deer Lake. The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to publish notice of adoption of this ordinance as required by law.




