BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following equipment will be sold to Grant County and that the sale value of said unit has been established and the agreed to purchase price should be as follows:


Unit No. SI-103, 1992, Swenson Model SVFF2-14-60, 14' V-Box Sander, Purchase Price: \$750.00
