SETTING A HEARING DATE

WHEREAS, the Board finds that off highway/off-road recreational vehicles (OHVs) provide opportunities for a wide variety of outdoor recreation activities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 46.09.180, the Board adopted Ordinance 2007-02 to regulate the operation of non-highway vehicles on designated county roads and rights of way under its jurisdiction on November 5, 2007 and amended it on November 19, 2007 to remove Cozy Nook Road (portion of) from the list; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2007-02 as amended was repealed and replaced by Ordinance No. 6-2009 on July 20, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds a hearing should be scheduled to consider changes to Ordinance No. 6-2009 including deletion of or changes to roads already approved and the addition of new county roads and rights of way within Stevens County under the Board's jurisdiction;


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that:

1. A public hearing shall be held on **Monday, December 20, 2010 at 6:30 p.m.** at the Loon Lake Historical Society's Old Schoolhouse; 4000 Colville Road; Loon Lake, Washington to consider amendments to Stevens County Ordinance No. 6-2009; and
2. The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of the hearing as required by law.


