IN THE MATTER of Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Stevens County, Washington, declaring the intention to vacate and abandon the following described portion of County Road:

A portion of the Change in May Rd #1016 (aka May Road LMO #45850); said vacation commencing at a point approximately 2.40 miles north of said roads intersection with 5th and Main Streets in Colville and continuing in a northeasterly direction for approx. .33 mile; all within Section 32, Township 36 North, Range 39 East, W.M.


This matter coming on regularly for hearing on the 7th day of June, 2011, at 11:00 o'clock a.m., it appearing that notice of said hearing has been given for the time and in the manner provided by law, it further appearing that the portion of road described herein is no longer necessary as a public road; that the vacation will be a benefit to Stevens County, and there being no reasonable evidence presented in opposition to the vacation and abandonment thereof, and the Board being fully advised in the premises.




