WHEREAS, due to width and geometric limitations combined with numerous traffic conflicts and increased traffic through a predominantly recreational area it is deemed to be in the interest of public safety and welfare of inhabitants of Stevens County to reduce the maximum rate of speed at which vehicles shall operate on the Black Lake Road, more particularly described hereinafter;





NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED, the Board finds and declares it is a public necessity to establish that it is unlawful for any person to drive and operate a motor vehicle over and along the Black Lake Road, Co. Rd. Number 49390 in Stevens County in excess of twenty five (25) miles per hour;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that proper signs denoting said reduced speed limit be erected on the above Stevens County Roadways where deemed necessary.
