WHEREAS, due to increased vehicle and pedestrian traffic and existing roadway geometrics on the Orin Rice Road No. 93700, it is deemed to be in the interest of public safety to reduce the maximum speed at which motor vehicles shall be operated, and

WHEREAS, changes to the maximum speed limits established by R.C.W. 46.61.400 may be made by local jurisdiction under the authority of R.C.W. 46.61.415,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that it shall be unlawful for any persons to drive and operate a motor vehicle over and along the Orin Rice Road No. 93700, from MP 0.00, which is the intersection with SR 25, to MP 0.48, at speeds exceeding 25 MPH.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that proper signs denoting said speed limit be constructed, as deemed necessary by the County Road Engineer, at appropriate places along said County Road.

Passed by the Board of Stevens County Commissioners meeting in regular session at Colville, Washington, by the following vote, then signed by its membership and attested to by its Clerk in authorization of such passage the 20th day of September, 2011.
