

Loon Lake Area

Larson Beach Rd from Hwy 395 to S Loon Lake Rd (Map page 66A). This segment of road starts at the southern end of Loon Lake at the Larson Beach Road intersection at Hwy 395. This area is noted with moderately heavy traffic, especially during summer season. This road transits through the populated residential areas. In approximately 1 mile, at the intersection of Larson Beach Road and South Loon Lake Road, stay to the left on South Loon Lake Road. In another mile, continue to bear left at the next intersection at Lake Shore Homes. Do not use Lake Shore Homes. The next intersections (approx 1.5 miles) are the Silver Beach Road residential areas. Again, stay to left on the main road of South Loon Lake Road. As the main road progresses north, it assumes the Shore Acres Road nomenclature near the Shore Acres residential areas, marked by Robert Rd and Shore Acres Rd intersections.

Lyon Moss Rd from Colville Rd to end (Map page 67). This 2.5 mile section of road accesses public lands to the north. From the road, there is access to a trail which transits state land up to North Deer Lake Road, where OHV's can cross Hwy395 and continue on into USFS lands further north and east. Be cautious as private property lies at the end of Lyon Moss Road. The trail to access state land should be marked. Use caution crossing Hwy 395 at the user-defined crossing point north of the North Deer Lake intersection.

McVay Rd from Hwy 292 to Shore Acres Rd (Map page 66A). This short segment of road provides access from the community of Loon Lake westward to intersect with Shore Acres Rd, accessing the western and southern areas of Loon Lake. It is hilly, with curves, so caution should be exercised to keep dust down, and safe clearance from traffic.

Morgan Rd from North Shore Drive to Hwy 292 (Map page 66A). Provides access into residential area for North Shore Dr and residences. Recommended for residents and guests only in North Shore/Morgan Park area only.

North Shore Drive from Hwy 292 to Gwenelen Rd (Map page 66A). Provides access into residential area for North Shore/ Morgan Park residences. Recommended for residents and guests only in North Shore /Morgan Park area only.

Shore Acres Rd from McVay Rd to S Loon Lake Rd AND Shore Acres Rd from Hwy 292 to McVay Rd (Map pages 67 and 66). This is the continued section of main gravel road that runs north-south along the west side of Loon Lake. Be cautious of heavy summer traffic along this section of road, as most residential access on the western shore of Loon Lake gains access from this road. Also, be cautious of foot traffic and bicyclists using the road. Shore Acres Road is gravel, and dust is a problem. Be courteous, keep speeds low to keep dust down.

Sunset Bay Rd from Hwy 395 to Hwy 395 (Map page 66A). This short segment of road is designated for the recreational area residents and guests.

Sunset Drive from Sunset Bay Rd to end (Map page 66A). This short segment of road is designated for the recreational area residents and guests.

Colville Rd from Hwy 292 to Hwy 292 (Map page 66A). This street allows for continued access from the services area near Hwy 395 enroute to Cedar St or Lyons & Moss Road. Use caution crossing Hwy 395. Cross north of the Garden Spot/Hwy 292 several hundred feet north, near the bend in the road of Colville St. The Cedar St. route carries across Hwy 292 to Morgan Rd and into the North Shore residential area. Continuing straight ahead on Colville will lead to McVay Road, by crossing Hwy 292 and the railroad tracks.

Maple St from Hwy 395 to Colville Rd (Map page 67). This section of road provides access from across Hwy 395 at Agar Road. From this northerly point, travelling south on Maple St. leads to the community of Loon Lake for services, or connects to the western Loon Lake access routes.

Cedar St from Hwy 292 to Colville Rd (Map page 66A). This short segment of road is available to make access to Colville Road, Morgan Road, and other routes accessible.
